**VENUE:**

Cannons Hill Raceway, Binsted Nr, Alton.Hants. GU34 4NS And will be signed from the A31 Farnham / Alton Road, Junction of B3004, **Please** follow the orange direction arrows and drive slowly through the Village. **PLEASE DO NOT TRY TO USE ANY SHORTCUTS / BACKROADS.**

**SIGNING ON:** 9.00 -10.30am. All riders to sign on before scrutineering. Evidence of current ACU and club membership to be shown. There will be a meeting of riders and crews at 10.40am. Maximum of 2 support crew per rider allowed in refuelling area, but NO outside assistance is allowed. All support crew must sign on.

**SCRUTINEERING:** 9.00 -10.30am. Please ensure you are scrutineered in time. PUSH your bike into Park Ferme. ALL helmets must be ACU approved and in good condition.

ALL Machines must have a FIM approved Enduro or Trials type pattern tyre on the rear wheel, Max tread depth 13mm. **NO M.X. tyres, NOT even road legal ones.** It's the same for everyone. Front optional. Enduro Silencers (112db) must be fitted NO M/X ones allowed, Fire extinguishers and Environmental Mats to be shown at scrutineering.

**CLOTHING:** Protective clothing must be worn as per E.S.R.'s.

**TYPE OF EVENT:** 3 Hour Hare & Hounds Enduro You will need wrist bands for electronic timing equipment. These will be handed out at Signing On and **WILL BE WORN** on the **RIGHT** wrist and on top of any clothing. Please scan these at the completion of each lap **including** your last one and PLEASE RETURN at the end of the day. When the 3 hours are up the course will be closed and your finishing time recorded to be classed as a finisher you must cross the line and scan **AFTER 1400 hours.** Support crew records will not constitute a record of performance.

**START:** Will be with **DEAD ENGINES** (5 mins. Warm up will be allowed prior to the start) Riders will start at 11.00am in Class Order, Championship followed at 30 second intervals by Expert/Vet A /Vet A/O50, Clubperson A/Vet B/Vet B/O50, Clubperson B /Evo, Sportsperson.

**EXCLUSION:** **Course cutting**, refuelling outside allotted area, riding in the car park or "Out of Bounds" areas. **Any rider with an excessively noisy exhaust during the event will be stopped and have 10 minutes to rectify.**

**NUMBERS:** Riders must provide their own and fit them on either side of the machine and on the front. Backgrounds as per A.C.U. handbook. Hazel Collins will be on site with Numbers and Backgrounds etc.

**SAFETY:** Will the slower riders please move over for the faster riders and the faster riders please be patient with the slower riders. **THANK YOU.**

**REFRESHMENTS:** Will be available by *☺*caughty but *☺*ice, please support them.

**FIRST AID:** By SSG UK Specialist Ambulance Services Ltd.

**REFUELING:** Allowed only in the allotted area with **DEAD Engines, NOT ALONGSIDE IT.**

**Note:** all **BLUE** taped areas including the **Start & Finish area** are **WALKING PACE ONLY.** This will be strictly enforced, Penalty Exclusion.
